

Title: JRC's activities report

An overview of the CAP checks Campaign 2017 will be given, including both issues of image acquisition volumes, success rates etc. and of number of OTSC performed. Meanwhile the preparation of the 2018 Campaign has started with the so-called pre-Image Requests on hand. This will allow the presentation to point at volumes, and new issues for the upcoming 2018 Campaign, such as the exclusion of autumn/winter HR periods in favour of the Copernicus S2 freely available data.

Moreover, the technical guidance for 2018 (especially the CTS), and the VHR and HR Specs 2018, new sensors, and advances in the G4CAP application will be briefly presented.

At last, a status of the Pilot4CAP Web application will be made (<https://g4cap.jrc.ec.europa.eu/G4CAP/pilot4cap>).

This platform was created by the JRC upon the request of the MS Administrations and DG AGRI for sharing/reporting of publicly known, new, or ongoing, Pilot projects for the new CAP2020+. Facts of projects, no. of Pilots, accesses and users of the DB etc.

Options for its future should be discussed.
