GSAA

- Since 2007
- 100% of IACS based schemes and measures since 2007, also
- Reference parcel - Physical block
- Geo data from farmers devices are allowed during the application process
- On line declaration since 2018

Data available to the farmers during GSAA

- Orto photo map – up to date
- Physical blocks – take the number of municipalities in which PB has a bigger area
- Eligible areas – layer
- Permanent grasslands – layer
- Temporary grasslands – layer
- Natura 2000 – areas and information for prohibits
- Lands with high natural value – layer
- LFA - layer
- Habitats of wintering geese, Imperial Eagle, Egyptian Vulture, Red-breasted Goose, etc. – layer
- Information for the location of the parcels from the previous year, which beneficent has been claimed
- Filled application for beneficent which is claimed previous year - he could make only needed amends
- Information about agriculture parcels or parts of them, which were found as a double declared previous year
- Employees assist applicants when filling in the applications for registration and identifying the areas they use
- Etc.

Declarations before 2014



- The rule for "land in a disposal of the farmer" is not presented, yet.
- The declared area is mostly by the visible boundaries, but not always.
- Overlapping between declarations is an issue.

Declarations after 2014



- The rule for "land in a disposal of the farmer" is presented.
- The declared area is by the virtual borders often, but not always .
- Overlapping between declarations is almost missing.

Reasons

- Cadaster is not up to date
- Physical blocks used permanently visible boundaries
- Cadaster is not separated by real boundaries
- Private legal issues
- Misunderstanding of the meaning “disposal of” which some of the farmer's evaluation that to “property by cadaster”.
- Municipal areas are not separated by the visible borders, but it's mandatory to be used for ANC/LFA layer (RD related)
- Some layers are created according to the boundaries different from the LPIS – NATURA 2000 (RD related)

- National legislation changed with the focus that the declaration should be by an “agriculture parcel” and the land should be on “disposal of” but not by the cadaster.
- Awareness and training campaigns prior to the start of the campaign with main goal explanation that “disposal of” doesn't mean “cadaster boundaries”
- We do not have a valid action to take in relation to the mandatory use of borders other than the visible with regard to building the layers related to the RDP.
